Camp Goodwater Policies

The following is important information about Camp Goodwater that will assist both you and your child in receiving the greatest benefit from the camp experience.

1. Georgetown Parks and Recreation strictly adheres to a clean language policy adopted by the City as well as a belief in the value of trust, effective communication, professionalism, team work and quality of life. We expect nothing less of the counselors that will be working with your children. In return, we expect the best from your child. We reserve the right to ask that your child not participate in camp if they display repeated poor language or poor behavior, which jeopardizes a safe camp environment.
2. Campers must arrive to camp on time, no later than 9:15. Please do not bring your child after this time. If you need to schedule doctor/dentist appointments for your child during camp, please plan on them not attending camp that day. Most all of the camp activities take place at a variety of locations. Staff will not be available to accommodate the different schedules of each child.
3. We will conclude camp programming at 4:00 in time for pick-up. However, please allow us a few minutes on field trip days to allow for traffic or unforeseen circumstances. The GISD buses are only allowed to drive at 55mph on the highway. If we are not back as scheduled, you may check on our location by calling the Recreation Center at (512) 930-3596.
4. Campers who exhibit negative behavior during camp will receive a timeout. The child's parents will be informed of the behavior. If the behavior is of a serious nature (fighting, leaving their group or being unsafe with their peers) the child will be asked not to return to camp. Repeated negative behavior will be documented on a Behavior Report and if the child receives three reports the child will be asked not to return to camp.
